Raschig, German Protestant Minister, a copy of which is hereunto attached, marked Exhibit "A", and made part hereof. Applicant further states that the record of said marriage in the Probate Court aforesaid was lost or destroyed in the burning of the Court House, March 29th, 1884. Whereof affiant prays that the record of said marriage may be restored, and further affiant sayeth not.

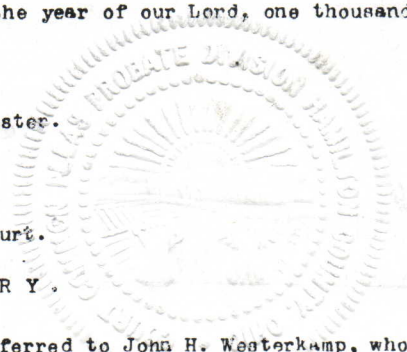
